Both NEDO and INCJ aim to implement and achieve specific business projects.

2. Promotion of industrial technology

NEDO and INCJ will work cooperatively to create new industries through the promotion of industrial technology with sharing both knowledge and expertise in industrial and technological trends.

3. Establishment of review committee

To promote items 1 and 2 above, INCJ and NEDO will establish a review committee composed of executives from both organizations.
