
Orthokeratology: A technique for improving the daytime "naked eye" vision of people with myopia and myopic astigmatism through the use of "night lenses" (contact lenses worn while asleep to temporarily reshape the cornea). The cornea retains that corrected shape for some time, over which uncorrected vision is better than it would be otherwise.
